# Steve McCurry : The Iconic Photographs



Les photographies de Steve McCurry sont de magnifiques tableaux dont la palette des couleurs est unique et fascinante. Cet ouvrage aux dimensions imposantes, d'une facture exceptionnelle, n'est disponible que dans cette édition limitée de 3000 exemplaires et comprend un tirage réalisé exclusivement pour Phaidon, numéroté et signé par Steve McCurry.

L'ouvrage comprend 200 des plus belles et plus marquantes photographies de Steve McCurry, prises sur les continents asiatique, africain et européen. Il inclut notamment le fameux portrait de la jeune fille afghane aux yeux verts, ses photographies des rues indiennes, des temples d'Angkor au Cambodge ou encore des temples bouddhistes au Tibet.

Photographe admiré, Steve McCurry est membre de l'agence Magnum Photos depuis 1986. Sa carrière débute en 1979 alors que, vêtu d'un costume traditionnel local, il pose le pied en territoire afghan, sur le point d'être envahi par les Russes. Ce reportage lui vaudra la prestigieuse médaille d'or Robert Capa, décernée aux photographes faisant preuve d'un courage et d'un esprit d'initiative exceptionnels.
